Bellevue utility finds no violations

Puget Sound Energy, the **Bonneville Power Administration** and Avista Corp. all told the **Federal Energy Regulatory Commission** yesterday that their internal investigations turned up no evidence of improper trading or transactions during the West Coast energy crisis last year.

The commission has been asking utilities, trading companies and others for information in an inquiry sparked by allegations that **Enron** and others were manipulating electricity prices.

Bellevue-based Puget was a particular focus because it was mentioned by name in one Enron memo as a customer of one of the trading practices in question. Puget said yesterday its internal investigation "found no evidence of wrongdoing."
