Tesler was most recently vice president of shopping experience at Amazon.com, where he worked from October 2001 to April 2005. Prior to joining Amazon.com, Tesler was President of Stagecast Software, developer and publisher of Creator, one of the most popular introductory computer programming tools in computer camps and many schools.

From 1980 to 1997, Tesler held a series of executive positions at Apple Computer, Inc., including chief scientist, vice president of engineering, and vice president of the advanced technology group. He played an integral role in establishing Apple as a leader in user interface, object-oriented programming, and multimedia technologies.

From 1973 to 1980, Tesler was part of the Xerox Palo Alto Research Center, where he helped to develop several techniques such as "cut and paste" and "modeless editing" that have become common in graphical user interfaces. Prior to that, he held a research position at the Stanford Artificial Intelligence Laboratory and was president of Information Processing Corporation, an applications software development company.

Tesler was a founding director of ARM, the world's leading provider of microprocessor intellectual property and served on the board for 13 years. He is a member of the board of the Gorilla Foundation (Koko.org), a non-profit conservation group, and of Stagecast Software.

Tesler received a B.S. in Mathematics from Stanford University in 1965.
